PAKISTAN

The Pakistan Chapter of WMO is among one of the most active branches. Helping hundreds of children and youth achieve their dreams of becoming successful professionals, the Chapter has undertaken education as a key focus and operates the Education for All and Higher and Professional Education schemes.

The Education for All scheme accommodates 7400 students in primary and secondary levels & the Professional Education Scheme assists 761 students pursuing higher education including Medicine, Dentistry, Accountancy & Law.

With annual costs for the two schemes running at around US\$ 1.7 million for student fees and assistance, the two schemes rely on donations for their continuance and success. With the dreams and futures of thousands of children and young adults depending on these projects, generous donations will be very welcome.

In addition, the Chapter also declared open the Memon Institute of Hijama Therapy (MIHT) in Karachi in February this year. The clinic offers treatment based on Hijama, recommended by the Sunnah of The Holy Prophet (sal). Since the Clinic runs on a non-profit basis the cost of treatment is very reasonable, and the number of patients seeking treatment has been rapidly increasing since its inception.
